

# Precautionary Surface Cleaning Protocol

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## 1. Remove excessive trash and debris.

The customer is asked to remove all excessive dirt, food and drink containers, organic material, and other trash prior to technician arrival. Excessive debris will inhibit the effectiveness of precautionary cleaning.

## 2. Wear PPE

Technician will wear protective gloves and safety glasses as determined and provided by Thompson Tractor.

## 3. Apply Solution

Prior to working on machine, spray compartment door handles, hand rails, operator door exterior, operator door interior, steering wheel, control levers, dash, and any other accessible operator compartment components with pre-mixed solution as recommended per CDC guidelines. Let solution rest for 10 minutes prior to removing.

*(Use caution to keep solution from any cloth panels, seats, carpets etc. You may need to spray cloth and wipe surfaces instead of spraying surfaces directly)*

## 4. Remove Solution

Wipe off/ dry vigorously residual solution with paper towels prior to servicing equipment. Place paper towels in trash container to be returned to Thompson Tractor Facility for disposal. *(Remove Cleaning PPE and Wash Hands)*

## 5. Perform Preventative Maintenance or make any necessary repairs to the equipment using appropriate PPE and established safety protocols.

## 6. After servicing or repairing equipment, repeat steps 2, 3 and 4.

## 7. Return equipment to service.
